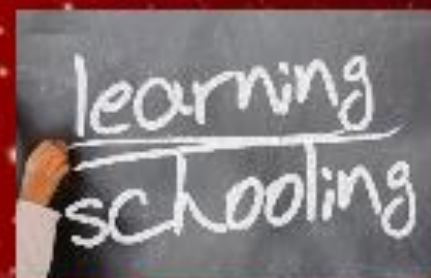
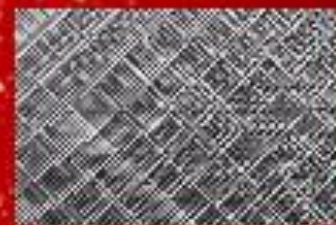
Charles Dickens by Dawson
