Charles was born on 2/7/1812



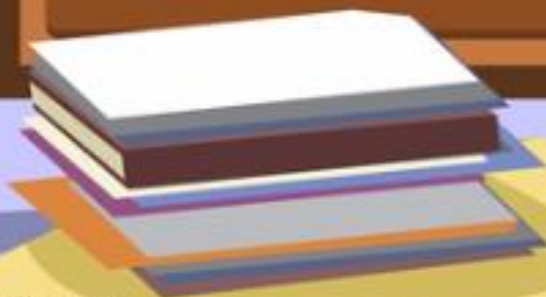
In 1837, Charles started editing a monthly paper called, "Bentlys Miscellany."
