

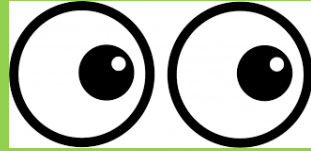


Digital Citizenship Lessons

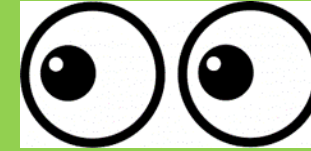
All classes will be taught Common Sense Media Digital Citizenship lessons in the Learning Commons through August 26th.
